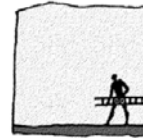


THE 2010 WESLEY BALK OPERA • MUSIC-THEATER INSTITUTE REGISTRATION FORM

- **ALL PARTICIPANTS** : Please include a resumé, along with both pages of this registration form and the letter of introduction described on the back side of this form (Performers: a recent photo is useful but not required).
- **PERFORMERS AND COACHES** : Please include a clearly-labeled CD or cassette for scene placement, with two contrasting selections in any language. This will help us cast you in appropriate scenes. If you send a commercial CD or recital with many selections, please specify which ones you want us to hear. And although it seems obvious, we'll say it anyway: PLEASE PUT YOUR NAME ON THE CD!
- **DIRECTORS AND COACHES** : A pre-Institute meeting for directors and coaches will be held on Saturday June 19th, so plan to arrive a day earlier than performers.

Apartment-style dormitory housing on campus is available. Single rooms (without meal service) are about \$45 per night. Do you want us to hold a room for you? Housing payments are due on May 28th.

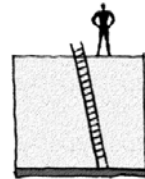

This letter may be included with your registration (in a sealed envelope), or sent to us under separate cover. It should be a true LETTER OF INTRODUCTION, not a regular letter of recommendation. It should provide us with information about you so that we can anticipate how best to serve you. **Please be sure to convey this distinction to whomever you are asking to write this letter.**
